### Donation Received ... what a wonderful story!

Sennen School has received a truly heartening donation, in memory of Gladys Webster, who attended Sennen School during WWII. Gladys loved Sennen and her time at this school. She maintained links with the area, along with her family, who felt it was a fitting tribute to give any donations that were received in her memory to Sennen school, along with some Forget-Me-Not seeds to plant....

Gladys Webster 14.09.1931 - 16.06.2025

Gladys, (then Gladys Tarbuck) attended Sennen School from June 1940 until May 1945.

An evacuee from London, Glady arrived at Penzance station with a small bag and gas mask with a label pinned to her! Since there was no room in the school building, lessons were held on the stage in the church hall with afternoons spent on the beach. Her sister Rose also attended the school but as she was older her lessons were held in the main church hall (with the classes separated by a curtain). Gladys lived with a family on Mayon Farm and Rose lived in Rose Cottage in the Cove.

Although there was a war on, Gladys had a lovely childhood in Sennen and found it very hard returning to London at the end of the war. She returned to the place she loved regularly, her last visit being when she was 91.

Such a thoughtful gesture and inspiring reminder of the lasting impact our school and community has on many people.


