
Topic




During the first half of the Autumn term, we will be focusing on our topic of `Me and My World'. We are beginning the topic by exploring books such as 'What makes me a me?', 'Owl Babies', 'The Colour Monster', 'We're going on a bear hunt'.



Maths



We will be beginning our learning in maths by exploring numbers up to 5. We will be considering all the different ways we can represent numbers up to 5 before moving on to numbers up to 10. We will also be focusing on our understanding of 2D shapes.

Read Write Inc



We have started our Read Write Inc. sessions in school. Please remember to come along on **Wednesday 25th September at 2.45pm** where we will be running a phonics workshop to help you understand how your child will be taught phonics and to take away the fear of helping your child at home to make those first steps into reading.

As we begin our journey into reading, there will be a variety of pictures sent home on Tapestry for you to look at together and discuss before children start bringing home books with short words in to practise reading. Look out for more information on this as we progress through the term!

We will begin visiting the school library very soon and children will be able to choose one story book to borrow and then return each week. Please make time to enjoy sharing these together. We can only allow one book to be loaned at a time so these will need to be returned before any others can be given out.

Home Learning



In Foundation, we very much work in partnership with you so love to see all the different things you get up to at home. The children love sharing photos and videos which have been uploaded onto Tapestry so please do share these and any wow moments you see at home. If you are struggling to get onto Tapestry, please come and see us.
