Optional Activities: These are some ideas for some extra activities you could do and exchange for dojo points.

In geography we will be finding out about Great Britain. Create your own poster telling people about an aspect of Great Britain that you are interested in. Some ideas may be history, football, food or festivals.

Science- This term we are finding out about rocks and the different types of rock. Can you make a fact file or poster to inform people about rocks?

How can I support my child at home?

- Encourage your child to complete all the homework tasks above.
- Remind your child to speak to an adult in school if they find things too easy or tricky.

- Have a look at the optional activities together and try to complete one of the tasks or find out more about that topic area (any extra learning is great!).
- If your child is finding things difficult, remind them to have a try and persevere. We would rather the tasks were attempted, than not completed at all.
- Talk about where different places are in the world. Where do you live? Do you know the compass points?
- Try to identify different rocks and count how many minerals you can see in the rock.
