- If your child is finding things difficult, remind them to have a try and persevere. We would rather the tasks were attempted, than not completed at all.
- Talk about where different places are in the world. Where do you live? Do you know the compass points?
- Try to identify different rocks and count how many minerals you can see in the rock.
